COMMUNITY GARDEN: The Community Garden offers 62, 5' x 13' personal gardening plots that are available for reservations on an annual basis. Applications for the Community Garden are available online or in person at the Craig Ranch Park Office. The annual fee is \$150 per plot and includes water usage.

FARMERS MARKET: On the Ranch Farmers and Artisan Market is open every Sunday (rain, shine and holidays) inside Craig Ranch Regional Park. Summer hours are 8:00am-1:00pm through September.
